1 kilo, 10oz, 1oz releases

A laughing kookaburra, the largest member of the kingfisher species, is synonymous with the Australian bush. In 2016, The Perth Mint releases three silver bullion coins portraying a kookaburra perched on a fence post amidst an Australian landscape.

Mintage

Only 500,000 1oz coins will be released. No mintage limit applies to the 1 kilo and 10oz coins for 12 months. However, production will close at the end of 2016 and The Perth Mint will declare each coin's official mintage.

Only 300,000 1oz coins will be released. No mintage limit applies to the 1 kilo coin for 12 months. However, production will close at the end of 2016 and The Perth Mint will declare the coin's official mintage.
