About the Kangaroo

The kangaroo is the largest marsupial surviving on earth today. The animal's distinctive style of movement, hopping on its hind legs whilst using its large, muscular tail for balance, means it is one of the only animals which is unable to move backwards easily. A recognisable symbol of Australia, the kangaroo features in the Australian national emblem alongside the emu.

Unlimited Mintage

No mintage limit applies to this coin for 12 months. However, production will close at the end of 2016 and The Perth Mint will declare each coin's official mintage.

Design Excellence

Our designs are award-winning and built on over 100 years of craftsmanship and minting superiority. The silver kangaroo coin's reverse depicts the iconic bounding red kangaroo surrounded by rays of sunlight. It also features the inscription AUSTRALIAN KANGAROO, the 2016 year-date and coin specifications as well as The Perth Mint's traditional 'P' mintmark.

Issued as legal tender under the Australian *Currency Act 1965*, the coin's obverse bears the Ian Rank-Broadley effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and the monetary denomination.

Guaranteed Weight and Purity

The weight and purity of each coin is guaranteed by the historic Perth Mint, owned by the State Government of Western Australia.

99.99% Pure Silver

The coin is meticulously struck from 1oz of 99.99% pure silver in bullion quality.

Presentation

This bullion coin is presented without capsules in protective acrylic tubes of 25 coins. There are 10 tubes to a box. Each tube is sealed with The Perth Mint's tamper evident security seal.
